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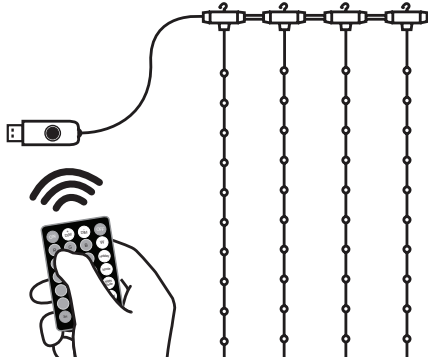

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Light doesn't work	Wont'turn on	Check the USB plug and socket for dirt or foreign matter, and ensure the plug is inserted firmly in place.
Remote doesn't work	Incorrect USB power	USB power supply must be 5V @ 1A minimum for proper operation. Excessive voltage may lead to product damage
Remote doesn't work	Remote battery	Replace CR2025 battery diagram on back of remote.

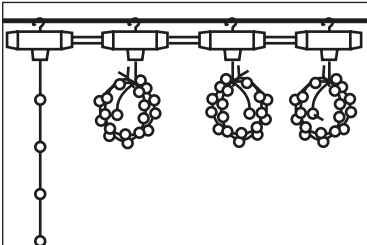

INSTALLATION

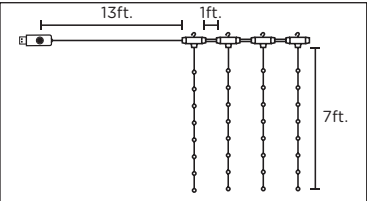
STEP 1: HANG CURTAIN LIGHTS

Use the built-in hooks to hang the curtain lights in your preferred indoor or covered outdoor location. Ensure the 13ft. USB power cord is within reach of a power source.

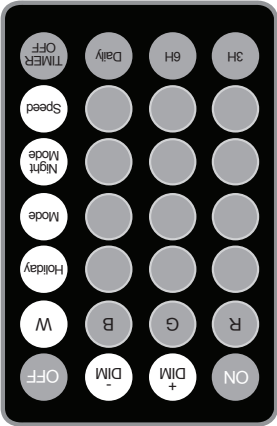


STEP 2: UNTIE LED STRINGS AND POWER CORD

Carefully untie and straighten out each LED string and the USB power cord.



NOTE: Point the remote directly at the USB controller to avoid extra IR interference.



SPEED BUTTONS: Increase/decrease speed (4x)

3H/6H BUTTONS: Light turns off after three or six hours

— lights will flash once to confirm timer is active

DAILY BUTTON: Light stays on for six hours, turns off

for 18 hours — lights will flash once to confirm timer

is active

TIMER OFF BUTTON: Deactivates 3H, 6H or Daily —

lights will flash twice to confirm timer cancellation

COLOR BUTTONS: Choose from 16 solid colors

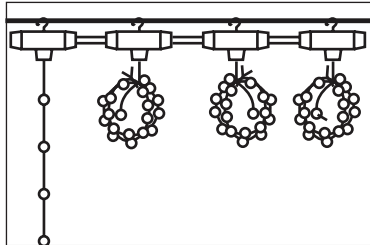

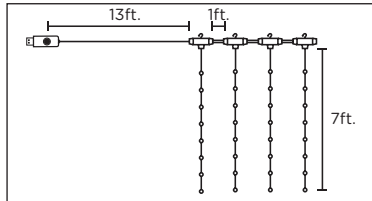

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Problema	Causa Posible	Solución
La luz no funciona	No enciende	Verifique que el conector USB y el puerto USB no estén sucios ni contengan material extraño, y que el conector encaje bien.
	Alimentación USB incorrecta	La fuente de alimentación USB debe ser de 5 V a un 1 A como mínimo para el funcionamiento correcto. Una tensión de alimentación superior a la normal puede provocar daños en el producto.
El control remoto no funciona	Pila del control remoto	Reemplazae la pila CR2025 teniendo en cuenta los polos. Consulte el diagrama en la parte posterior del control remoto.
